December 7, 2021 - Remembering Pearl Harbor

December 7, 1941, before 8:00 a.m., on Sunday morning, Japanese fighter planes descended on Pearl Harbor Naval Base, near Honolulu, Hawaii. This devastating surprise military attack by the Imperial Japanese Navy Air Service destroyed or damaged 20 American naval vessels, including eight battleships, and over 300 airplanes. Americans killed that day were more than 2,400. Included in this number were civilians with another 1,000 wounded. Fortunately, for the United States three aircraft carriers were out of port on sea trials. On December 8, 1941, President Franklin D. Roosevelt asked Congress to declare war on Japan. (A Date Which Will Live in Infamy). Every year on December 7th, National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day is held at Pearl Harbor National Memorial and Visitor Center, Honolulu, Hawaii. Pearl Harbor survivors along with veterans and others come together to honor and remember those who killed. In 1994, the United States Congress designated December 7 as a National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.
