Interesting Facts:

The history of MEMORIAL DAY. The history of Memorial Day is complex. Memorial Day, also known as Decoration Day was a holiday observed on May 30, from 1868 to 1970. In 1971, Congress standardized the holiday as (Memorial Day) and changed its observance to the last Monday in May. The United States Department of Veteran's Affairs recognizes 24 places that claim to have originated the holiday. Most of the 24 places being located in the southern part of the United States. The practice of decorating soldiers' graves dates before the American Civil War. In 1966, then President Lyndon B. Johnson proclaimed Waterloo, New York, as the place to first formally show observance on May 5, 1866, to honor men and women who died on duty in the United States Military. This is a day to show respect, mourn military personnel who have died in the line of duty. Military organizations and other volunteers place American flags on graves across the United States and at National Cemeteries (the Tomb of the Unknowns at Arlington National Cemetery) as an example.
