### **Interesting Facts:**

March of Dimes: The March of Dimes organization was founded by President Franklin Roosevelt in 1938 to combat the Polio epidemic. President Roosevelt himself was diagnosed with Polio in 1921. The name "March of Dimes" was coined by stage, screen and radio star Eddie Cantor. He inspired a nationwide fundraising campaign. Lapel pins were sold for ten cents each. Nearly everyone can send in a dime, Cantor's appeal to the nation resulted in a flood of donations (dimes) to the White House. President Roosevelt took to the air to thank the American people for their donations. He said, "In the past few days bags of mail have been coming to the White House. This also happen to be President Roosevelt's birthday. It is glorious to have one's birthday associated with a work like this." With these funds Jonas Salk produces a vaccine. Also, about the same time with the same funding Albert Sabin developed a simpler version of the vaccine. In 1976 the March of Dimes became known as the March of Dimes Birth Defects Foundation. The formal name changed to the March of Dimes Foundation in 2007.
